Following supper at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, June 17, Fr. Dwight Longenecker, parish priest at Our Lady of the Rosary and chaplain at St. Joseph's Catholic School, will open the retreat with an address on "Christ's Healing Ministry." Following Fr. 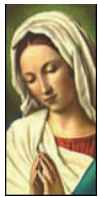
