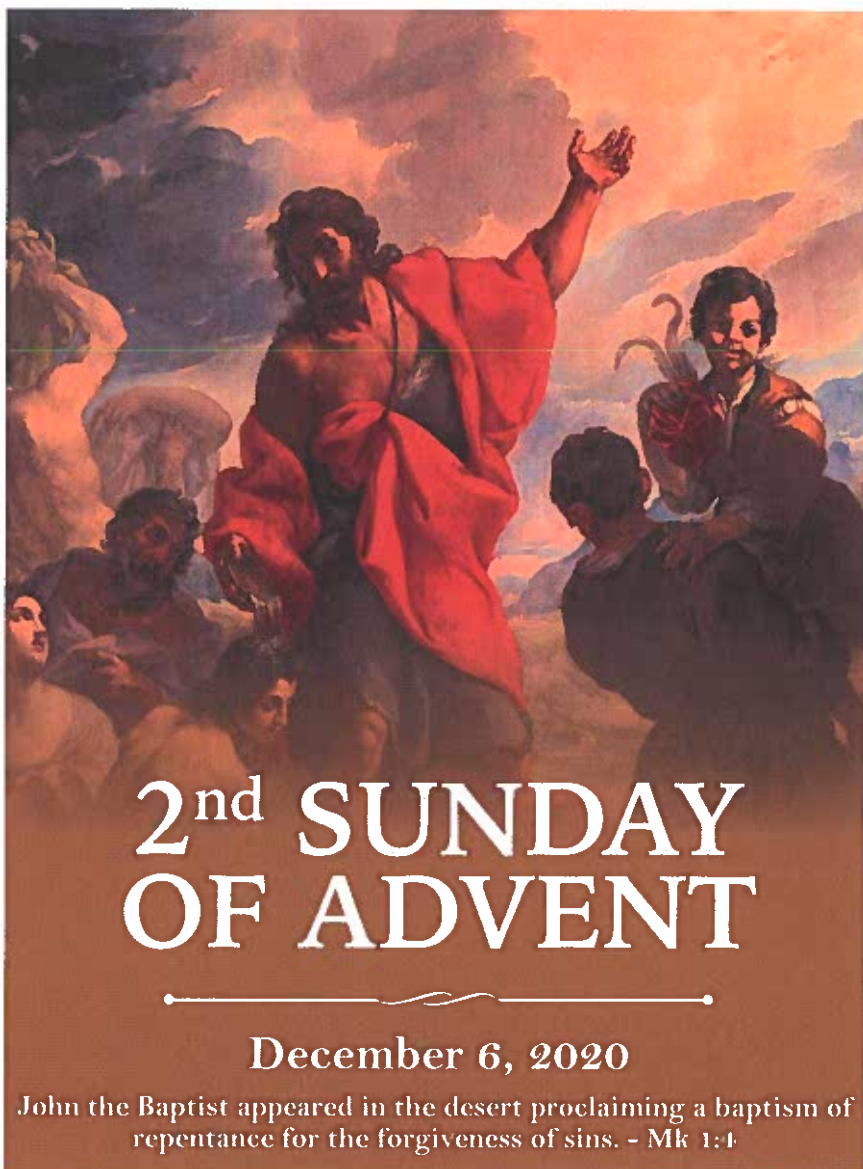

**UPDATE: MASS ATTENDANCE AND GROUP MEETINGS.**

Effective June 15, 2020, Bishop Guglielmo has given parishes permission to increase our allowable capacity to 50 % for Masses. 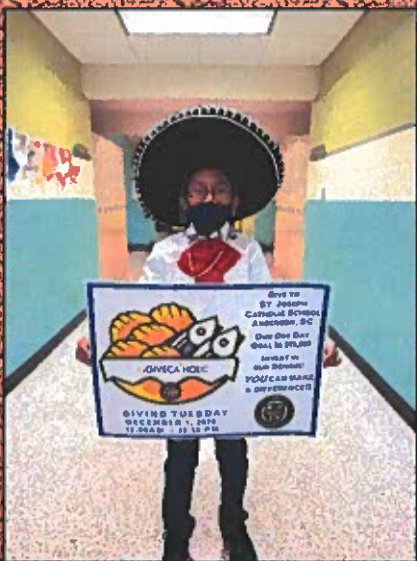
